Instructions to install expEDIum Claim Browser

STEP 1:

- Ensure Java run time is installed first (JRE 1.6.x or above).
- Run a command "java -version" from a command prompt. If Java is installed it displays the following (or similar) information.

```
java version "1.6.0_11"  
Java(TM) SE Runtime Environment (build 1.6.0_11-b03)  
Java HotSpot(TM) Client VM (build 11.0-b16, mixed mode,  
sharing)
```
- Please ensure that you have ONLY JRE 1.6.x (or a later version) installed on your system or the Path environment is setup correctly to give precedence to JRE 1.6.x (or a later version) instead of any earlier version (such as JRE 1.5.x) installed on your system. You can correct the precedence by inspecting your system environment "PATH" variable and ensuring that the path (for instance C:\JRE_1.6.0.11\BIN) where JRE 1.6.x or later version is installed appears prior to the path of JRE of an earlier version.

STEP 2:

- If Java is not already installed, download JRE 1.6.x or above from the Sun website at <http://www.java.com/en/download/manual.jsp>
- Choose "Windows (Offline Installation)" from this website and download the latest version of JRE available.
- Once downloaded, run the jre-1_6_0_11-windows-i586-p.exe (note the file name may be different based on the current version of JRE available at the Sun website) to install the JRE.
- Once JRE is installed, run the command from step 1 above to ensure that JRE is installed successfully.

STEP 3:

- WE have two options for downloading expEDIum Claim Browser: The EXE file, a self extractor zip file and the ZIP file. Both are provided as some firewalls might prevent the downloading of Executable files (.exe files). Both files are password protected.
- If you have downloaded the eCB-Installer.zip, unzip the file into any directory of your choice. (For example: C:\expEDIumClaimBrowser)
- If you have downloaded the eCB-Installer.exe, please note this is a self extracting zip file which will prompt you to select the destination folder.
- Please enter the password that was emailed to you by iTech Workshop when prompted to finish the installation.

expEDIum Claim Browser Installation Instructions

- The installation takes less than a minute after JRE is installed.

STEP 4:

- For additional information follow the HTML (<Installation Directory>\expEDIumClaimBrowser\expEDIum-Help\ECB\index.html) help file supplied with the product. You can run the expEDIumClaimBrowser.bat and bring the help file up by selecting the "Help>>Help Topics" in the Menu or alternatively you can type the F1 key to bring it up.
